BRIEF DESCRIPTION

Cornafulla is a mixed school the entire school campus takes up about 5 acres consisting of a newly extended school, beautiful landscaped gardens and extensive playing facilities.

The school first opened in 1843 and was extended in 1983. Another major extension was completed in 2010 consisting of additional classrooms, a sports hall, a library and a range of multi-purpose rooms. We are all delighted with and very proud of our state of the art new school.

The school implements the Primary School Curriculum 1999. In addition pupils are afforded the opportunity to study a (Modern) European Language, German.
